About Seacourt Print Workshop:

Seacourt Print Workshop is a creative hub in Bangor, North Down providing a unique space for engaging in creativity whatever your training or life circumstances. Our workshop is a place where people can come to make art, develop their skills and talents and connect with others.

We operate an open access printmaking studio and our printmaking family includes master printmakers, multidisciplinary artists, visiting artists, amateurs who experiment with art making, children and young people exploring creativity, those with mental health and disability who print to improve their well-being and people who love printmaking.

The Role Purpose:

We employ Printmaking facilitators on a freelance basis to deliver our ongoing course and workshop programme, our education programme, community projects and our health and wellbeing projects.

We require printmakers who are specialists and can demonstrate their experience of exploiting a technique and of sharing the processes and skills in a workshop or demonstration context.

The hourly rate is £25 per hour and where travel beyond Seacourt is involved we provide mileage expenses.

Relevant Experience:

Applicants must be able to demonstrate relevant skills and experience as follows:

1. A third level qualification in fine art or applied arts (or equivalent) with demonstrable experience of printmaking OR Five years practice as a Visual Artist specialising in printmaking

2. Two years experience of providing printmaking facilitation or tuition in schools, community or other relevant settings

Applicants must be able to:

- work flexible hours in line with organisational and client needs
- demonstrate good communication and inter-personal skills
- be able to make their own way to Seacourt or other community venues as required
- submit to an Access NI check
