


WHO WE ARE... AND WHAT WE DO

IYSC is a registered charity and company limited by guarantee with a board of directors.

Regular core funding is provided by the Arts Council for Northern Ireland (ACNI) and Derry City and Strabane District Council (DCSDC). Other core and project funding comes from ACNI, DCSDC, trusts and foundations, government departments, sponsorship, donations and earned income.

CATHEDRAL SCHOOL CAPITAL REDEVELOPMENT



IYSC have been given the exciting opportunity by St. Columb's Cathedral to lease the Cathedral School and transform it into our new home.

The location, on the city walls, will put us in the heart of the city. The space inside the building has huge potential to meet the needs and aspirations of the company.

The building is currently a shell, though the roof, walls and general structure has been made sound through an initial £1.5m restoration project in 2010.

It is estimated that the development costs to create a new circus centre at the former Cathedral school will be significant but we are excited and ready for the challenge.

This is the opportunity to bring this historic building back to life, and fill it with love and laughter.


Eavan King leads on Film Education at the Nerve Centre in Derry. Eavan is passionate about arts education and the potential for career development through engaging and immersive arts programmes.
