Talented young performers from local dance group **BELFAST BOYS** are set to travel to London to showcase their skills at the **U.Dance National Festival** after being selected from thousands of applicants nationwide. The dancers will perform at the prestigious event run by One Dance UK, taking place **from 25-27 July** at the brand-new Sadler's Wells East in London's Queen Elizabeth Olympic Park.

This remarkable achievement means the young dancers will join hundreds of their peers from across the UK for an extraordinary weekend of performances, workshops and career development opportunities in the capital.

The festival is organised by One Dance UK, the national support organisation for dance across the UK. The U.Dance programme supports youth dance groups throughout the year, culminating in the prestigious National Festival where young dancers get the chance to perform on a professional London stage as well as learn from industry experts.

About BELFAST BOYS

Noting that it was often difficult for boys to get involved in dance and other creative activities, as they are generally encouraged towards sports activities, by setting up Belfast Boys in 2017 we aim to positively discriminate towards them, spark their interest, and help them to see dance as a skilful, physically challenging and really enjoyable activity.

With funding from Arts Council of NI, the Belfast Boys have examined wellbeing and mental health through dance and movement, The group were struck by how common it is to experience melancholy, 'a feeling of pensive sadness, typically with no obvious cause'. Together in this piece they explore the narrative of how to help themselves and each other, in and out of this feeling.

Speaking about being selected for the festival, group leader/s **DEBORAH HAMILTON** says:

"It's a fantastic opportunity to perform and tour our work while representing NI. We are very proud of what we do and this event gives us time to connect with dancers representing many different regions. We look forward to workshopping with others, learning new skills and exploring new styles. It helps young dancers like us expand our horizons in dance and network with others (especially other male dancers) across the UK and the island of Ireland. We get to share, celebrate, workshop and perform alongside dancers from different dance backgrounds and communities. U Dance is AWESOME and lots of CRAIC!! "
